

# Ideas for Short Walks around Tadcaster - Number 2

## The Old Coach Road and Woodhouse Farm

Four miles : two hours or more ... Pack – Insect repellent for the wood

Starting at Tadcaster Bridge go up the hill and left onto Wighill Lane. Pass 3 turns on your right, the last being Hudson Way and then take the next track on the right. You are now on the old Coach Road to York.

Pass a farmhouse up on your right and then follow the track round as it makes a sharp right hand turn. In a short distance there is a left turn, but you need to go straight on here. Keep on the track until Woodhouse Farm.

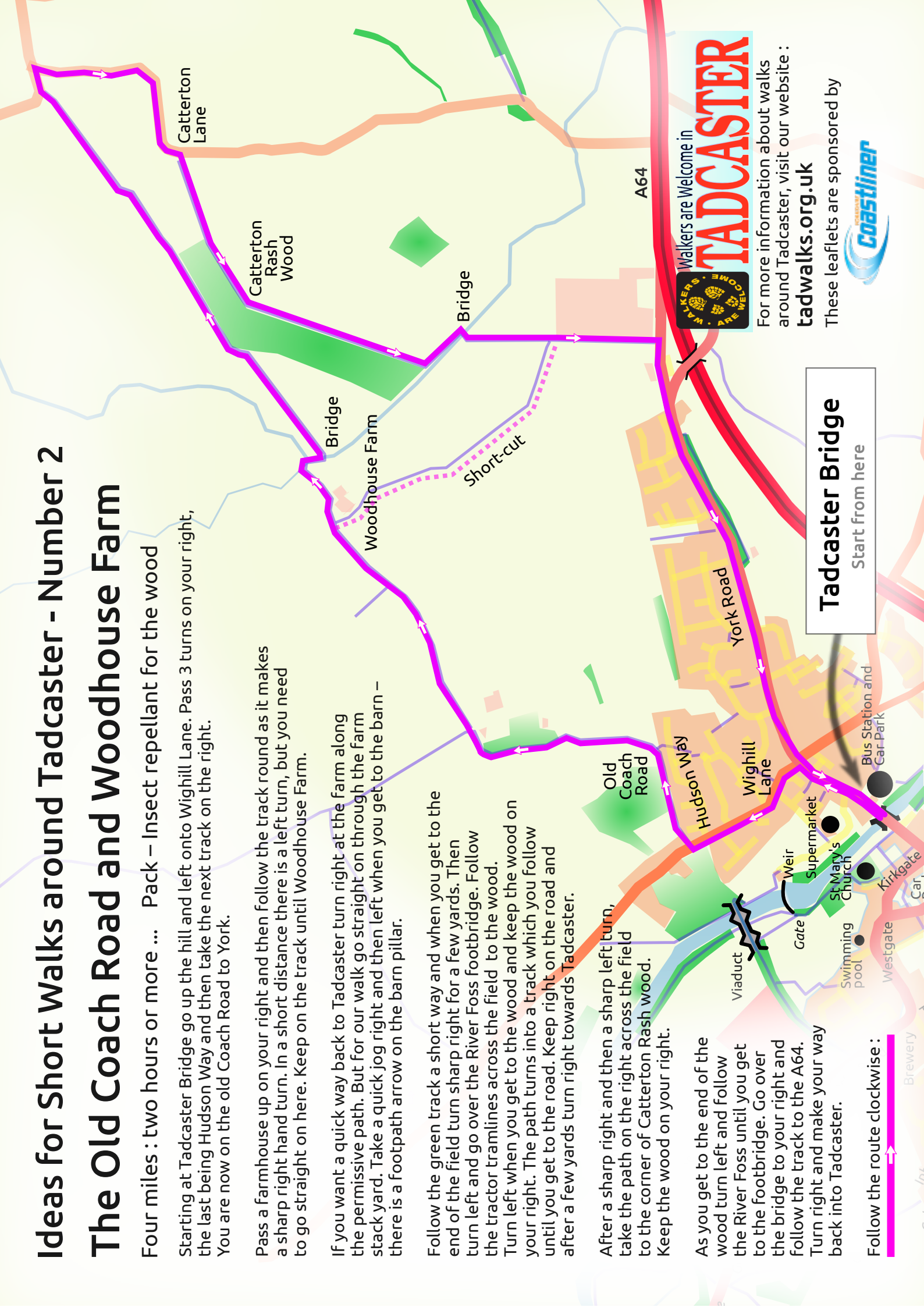
If you want a quick way back to Tadcaster turn right at the farm along the permissive path. But for our walk go straight on through the farm stack yard. Take a quick jog right and then left when you get to the barn – there is a footpath arrow on the barn pillar.

Follow the green track a short way and when you get to the end of the field turn sharp right for a few yards. Then turn left and go over the River Foss footbridge. Follow the tractor tramines across the field to the wood. Turn left when you get to the wood and keep the wood on your right. The path turns into a track which you follow until you get to the road. Keep right on the road and after a few yards turn right towards Tadcaster.

After a sharp right and then a sharp left turn, take the path on the right across the field to the corner of Catterton Rash wood. Keep the wood on your right.

As you get to the end of the wood turn left and follow the River Foss until you get to the footbridge. Go over the bridge to your right and follow the track to the A64. Turn right and make your way back into Tadcaster.

Follow the route clockwise :



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
